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Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations for cooks at The Township's 2nd Annual Fall Festival Chili Cookoff are as follows:

1. No ingredient may be pre-cooked in any way prior to the commencement of the official cookoff. The only exceptions are canned or bottled tomatoes, tomato sauce, peppers, pepper sauce, beverages, broth and grinding and/or mixing of spices. Meat may be treated, pre-cut or ground. MEAT MAY NOT BE PRE-COOKED. All other ingredients must be chopped or prepared during the preparation period.
2. You must be at least 18 years old.
3. The cooking period will be a minimum of 3 hours and a maximum of 4 hours. Cooking during entire cooking period is at the sole discretion of the contestant. Judging will begin at 12pm.
4. Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own cooking utensils and heat source. Toppings, serving bowls, side items and sampling materials should also be supplied. The sponsors of the cookoff will provide a 10x10 tent for each contestant, unless they want to supply their own. Participants may decorate tent as they want.
5. Each contestant must cook a minimum of two quarts of competition chili prepared in one pot, which will be submitted for judging. Then have ample supply for general public for sampling.
6. Judges will be told they should vote for the chili they like best based on the following major considerations: good flavor, texture of the meat, consistency, blend of spices, aroma, and color.
7. The decisions of the Chief Judge shall be final.
8. Judges will award a Winner for each category: Chili, Veggie Chili, Brunswick Stew and Salsa. There will be a People's Choice Award in each of these categories as well. Extra points will be awarded for Best Cook's Costume, Best Named Chili, Best Tent Decorations. Prizes will be awarded to all of the chosen winners.
